All paperwork must be picked up and processed at the Airman & Family Readiness Center before children may be registered.

Referral certificate will be good for 90 days from the date of issue.

Give Parents a Break (GPAB) is a program sponsored by the Air Force Aid Society, and held once a month at CDC3 and the Youth Center. Wondering if this program is right for you? Ask yourself these questions:

- Is your active duty spouse deployed or on extended TDY?
- Is your family dealing with a crisis or stressful situation?
- Are you at your wits end and just need a break?

If you answered YES to any of these questions, then this program is for you!

GPAB is held one Saturday a month, from 1:00 - 5:00 p.m., at CDC 3 and the Youth Center. You must pick up a referral certificate from the Airman & Family Readiness Center before registering your child.

This program is separate from the “Deployed Spouse Monthly Child Care Program,” which requires a separate referral form and registration.

Open to Children ages 6 months - 12 years old.
